The teacher will divide the class into four groups and assign each group a jumbled word. Students will work together to rearrange the letters and form a meaningful word. To add an extra challenge, students can be encouraged to use the appropriate article for the given word. For example, if the jumbled word is "pap e l," a student might correctly identify it as "apple" and then use the appropriate article, saying "an apple." उपविषय: - दो, तीन, चार अक्षर के शब्द

## <u>Actívíty - I Spy</u> Nouns

This group noun activity will be conducted in the classroom. The teacher will divide the students in a group of 5. Each group will be tasked with collectively identifying and recording 10 nouns found within the classroom environment (with each student contributing 2 words). Then the teacher will announce the marking for the responses.

Criteria- To give one point for common nouns, two points for proper nouns, and three points for collective nouns. The group that achieves the highest score will be declared the winner of the activity.


