

REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN THE MONTH OF JANUARY

ROLL & ADD ACTIVITY- To teach addition in a fun way 'Roll and Add Activity' was conducted for the Prep students. In this activity, students rolled two dice and recorded the number of dots per die in each box. They added the dots to get the sum. Students loved to roll the dice and find out the answers.



BUD PRINTING ACTIVITY- The idea of painting for kids inspires fun and creativity! Prep students explored the unique technique of 'Bud Printing' and tried their little hands on the fish. This activity also helped in developing fine motor skills and eye-hand concentration.



CLAY MODELLING ACTIVITY- ‘Clay Modelling Activity’ was organized for Prep students. The main objective of the activity was to help children develop imagination and spark creativity. Under the guidance and direction of their teachers, our little ones came up with their ideas and stunning creations. They pounded, squeezed, rolled and blended the clay to make the models according to the given theme ‘Vegetables’. The little hands worked smoothly and efficiently. This activity also gave them an insight into identifying and recognizing different types of vegetables.



NUMBER ACTIVITY- In this creative and interactive activity, students of class Nursery shaped the clay into numbers and verbally counted them. This activity helped the children understand numbers and boosted their cognitive skills.



TEARING AND PASTING ACTIVITY- Tearing and pasting activity is an excellent fine motor activity that helps the child to build and refine muscles in their little hands. It also improves hand-eye coordination. The little ones of class Nursery relished tearing tri-colour papers into small pieces and pasting them in pictures of kites. All the students participated with great excitement and eagerness.



HAND PRINTING ACTIVITY- To boost creativity and enhance the eye-hand coordination and fine motor skills of the children, the hand-printing activity was conducted in class Nursery. Students dipped their hands in various colourful paint and imprinted their palms on chart paper. The colours came alive on plain paper when the teachers and students together created wonderful peacocks from hand prints.



FINGER PRINTING ACTIVITY- Finger printing activity is a great way for children to explore, learn and develop through sensory play. Our little Rallians of class Pre-Nursery took active part in this activity. They dipped their fingertips and thumbs in different colours and made beautiful tri-colour kites. Such art activities are very important in early childhood as these activities help the body and brain to integrate information and it is also a most relaxing and creative way to express feelings.



TRICYCLE RIDING ACTIVITY-Tricycle riding in the Preschool Program is a favourite outdoor activity for children. This helps to develop gross motor skills, coordination, and balance. Riding on a line adds an even greater challenge of control of movement. Through this activity, our Pre-Nursery children also learnt the difference between left and right, forwards and backwards, and ‘stop’.
