

## GLIMPSE OF ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

Class – I

### Activity - Diya Decoration:

Diya decoration activity was conducted to help the students to explore their imagination, creativity and to celebrate the *Festival of Lights* in its true spirits. Students participated in this activity enthusiastically. They created beautiful diyas by colouring and decorating it.



### Activity : Our Community Helpers:



To make the students understand about the role and importance of the people who help us in our daily lives, a speaking activity was conducted in EVS class. Children took turn to speak about their favourite helper and they also dressed up alike.

### Activity : Describe Me:

It is always fun to learn in a creative way. Students understood about describing words by drawing an object of their choice and describing it in few words. This encouraged kids to think about the describing words.



### Class – II

### Activity: Making a Coat:



Winter season brings along a lot of joy and happiness. People wear different warm clothes in this season.

Making a coat activity was conducted in which students made a coat out of origami paper and decorated it. This activity made them develop their cognitive skills as they transformed the paper into a new piece of creation.

## Activity: Balance The Equations:

Addition and subtraction are useful for many activities in our everyday life.

Through this activity students created a balancing scale and wrote an addition and subtraction equation on both sides with the same answer. This enabled students to identify equations and balance their scale.



## Activity: Animal Bingo:



There are different types of animals around us. They provide us with many things. It is important for us to take care of the animals.

Animal Bingo activity was conducted in which students drew a grid, wrote animal names in it and identified different animals by solving the riddles spoken by the teacher.

## Class – III

To make learning more fun filled, students created a unique theme based pizza using the subject and verb toppings and make yummy sentences about pizza keeping in mind the sub-verb agreement rules learnt. It proved to be a creative and an educational activity for students, indeed! They thoroughly enjoyed doing the activity.



गतिविधियाँ विद्यार्थियों को अभ्यास के द्वारा दक्षता विकास के पर्याप्त अवसर देती हैं। ये सीखने की प्रक्रिया के दौरान विद्यार्थियों की रुचियों, क्षमताओं और आवश्यकताओं की पूर्ति करती हैं। नवंबर माह में कक्षा तीन के सभी वर्गों में अनेक शब्दों के लिए एक शब्द उपविषय पर आधारित गतिविधि (पॉपकॉर्न) करवाई गई, जिसका उद्देश्य विद्यार्थियों में भाषा के विभिन्न कौशलों का विकास करना तथा उनके ज्ञान को स्थाई रूप से मज़बूत बनाना था। इस गतिविधि के द्वारा विद्यार्थियों की शब्दावली, कलात्मकता, मौखिक एवं लिखित अभिव्यक्ति का विकास हुआ।

To develop the conceptual understanding of *division as repeated subtraction*, an activity **Build Your Division Snow Man** was conducted. In the activity, students used circle cut outs of different sizes to perform *subtraction in each circle till they get zero*. Later, students counted the number of circles they used. This gave the quotient. Students pasted these circle cut outs in the form of a snow man and decorated it using their creativity.

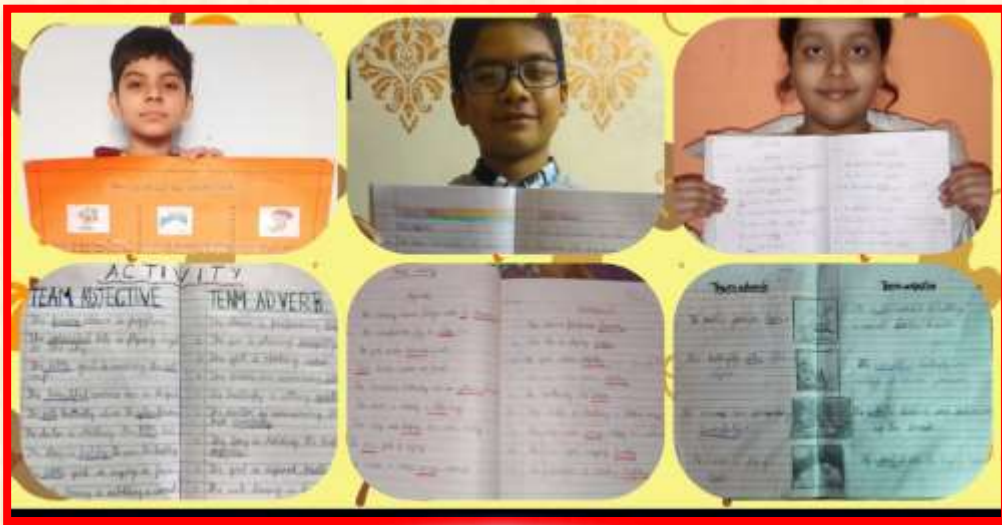

## Class – IV & V

### English

Teaching does not need to be limited to textbooks and blackboards. With the fun school activities for kids, learning in school becomes an interesting and enjoyable exercise. Keeping this thought in mind an activity based on the topic “Types of Verbs” was conducted for *grade IV* and a speaking activity based on “Adjective and Adverb” was conducted for *grade V*. These activities proved to be very fruitful for the children and enhanced their understanding on the topics.





## Math

In grade IV Math, an activity *Division Cone* inspired students to find out different division combinations with the same quotient and enhanced their creativity and knowledge about shapes.

In grade V, children understood the concept of decimal numbers through the *Decimal Cards* activity.





## EVS – I (Science)

Food is the essential for our body as it provides us energy for working, playing and doing day-to-day activities.

In Science, Children of Class IV have performed a check activity by labelling various food nutrients from their food packets and contemplate the value of that particular food as “Healthy or Junk”.



As we all know, Water the ‘Elixir of Life’ is one of our essential needs to survive. This water which we drink needs to be pure and free from germs. This purity can be achieved at home also by different methods.

Children of grade V, made a ‘2-D Model of Water Purifier’ representing different layers involved in filtering out the water depending upon the size of impurities and the size of the space between the particles.

Children of *grade IV* depicted the culture of Rajasthan and children of *grade V* presented the lifestyle of Saudi Arabia through a collage making activity.
