SESSION 2021-22

Class – I

Activity: My Paper Boat

Seasons are exciting and fun to explore with the kids.

Along with the learning to encourage their creativity, an activity of making their own paper boat was conducted in the class.



Activity : Christmas is here



Christmas brings out the spirit of giving and sharing joy and happiness. To make this wish come true, children beautifully decorated their own Christmas tree using different decorative materials.

Class – II

Activity: Pronoun Flower

Activity: Making of Groups

Repeated addition is the easiest way to progress from additive to multiplicative understanding.

Making of Groups activity provided an opportunity to the students to make groups of different materials and then write multiplication as well as repeated addition fact for the same.



Activity: Making of Kutcha House



A house provides us shelter, safety, identity and privacy.

Making of kutcha house activity was conducted in a fun way wherein students made a house using origami sheet and natural materials to make it look real. This activity stimulated their creative skills and enhanced their learning.

Class - III

They really loved being able to manipulate the words, frame them into sentences of their own and show ownership whilst placing them into their correct envelopes. The activity sharpened their ‘Tense Rules’ and proved to be a real fun- way learning Tenses!

The fun hands on activity was conducted in the class where children created a '3 D Model' of clock using paper-plates and colourful sheets and understood the importance of time in real-world.

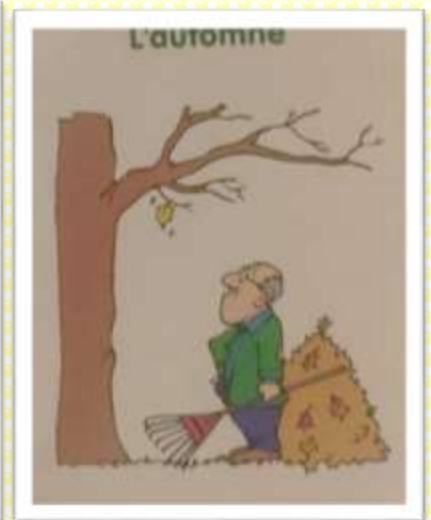

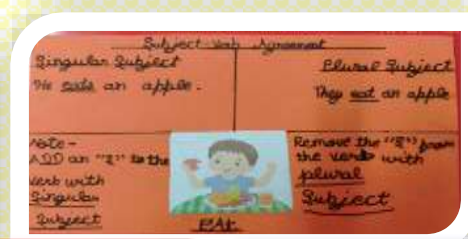
English

Students spoke excellent sentences using the flashcards made by them. These activities proved to be very fruitful and enhanced their understanding of the topics.

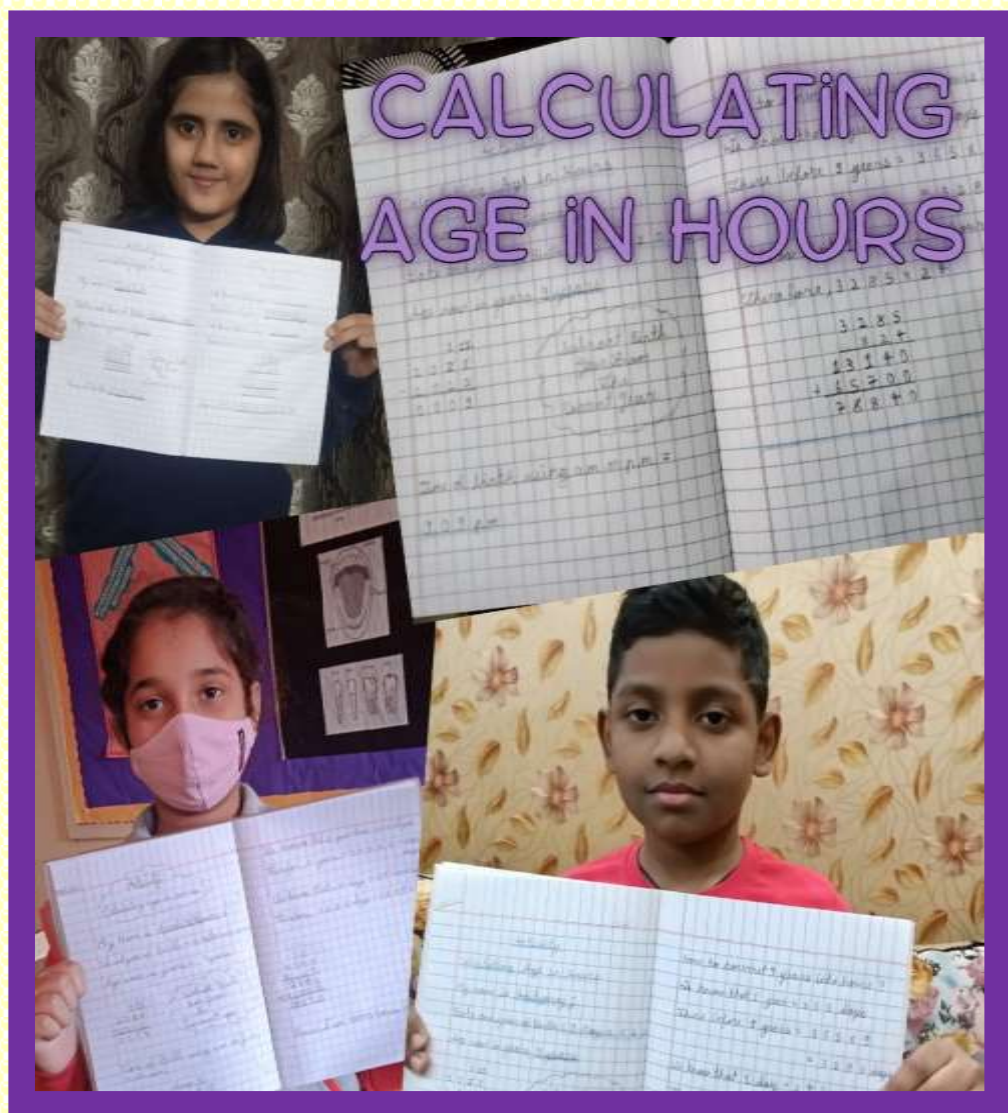
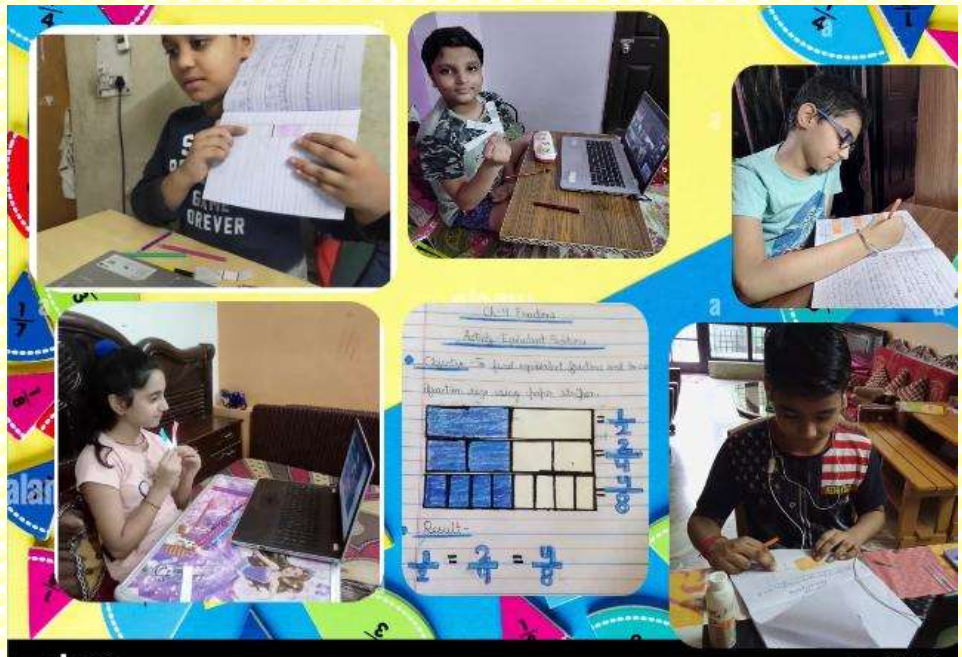
Overall, children exhibited a great participative spirit and had a fun-filled learning experience too.



Maths

Learning by rote can be tedious, but it needs to be done. So why not try doing all this by disguising the boring bits. Here's how!!

Students of grade IV & V experienced the fun way of learning in their Math class. Where grade IV students calculated their age and the age of their siblings in hours using conversions of TIME and grade V students understood the concept of equivalent fractions through paper folding.



EVS - I (Science)

The true method of knowledge is experiment. This assertion has been proven by the experiential learning activities conducted in Science Class of grade IV & V.

Students of grade 5 demonstrated an activity on *Different Phases of Moon* using their creative minds and used Oreo biscuits to display the phases of the Moon beautifully.



Children of grade IV performed **Starch Activity** and realised that how starch gets converted into simple sugars after reaction with saliva. The activity was performed virtually as well as in offline mode by using Iodine solution and different food items like rice, bread, potato and sugar.

EVS - II (SST)

In EVS – II class, children of grade IV made beautiful collage on *food items of Tamil Nadu*, and children of grade V showcased their creativity while making collage on life of the *Prairies*.

These activities helped children to revise and reinforce the concepts in an enjoyable and creative manner.
