REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

KITE MAKING ACTIVITY— Kite Making activity was done for Pre-Nursery students in the class. In this activity, students folded the origami sheet in different folds and made a beautiful kite. Through this activity they developed their fine motor skills.



PHOTOFRAME MAKING ACTIVITY- Children did a photo frame-making activity using different colored paint and lady finger. In this activity, they dipped ladyfinger in different colored paint and imprinted it on the frame. It is a fun way to learn impression painting for kids.







NUMBER COUNTING ACTIVITY- The number-counting activity is a fun way of learning and understanding numbers. In this activity, students identified the number and placed sticks according to it. It helped in improving their number recognition and understanding the value of numbers.

Children were shown different fruits and the teachers explained about the fruits found in the winter season. Children enjoyed sorting fruits according to their colour and season.



<u>CRAYON SHAVING ACTIVITY</u>- Our little artists of class Nursery did an involving and creative crayon shaving activity in their classes. They had been collecting shavings for quite a few days. They filled winter fruits with vibrant-coloured shavings. They thoroughly enjoyed the activity.



<u>HOPSCOTCH ACTIVITY</u>—Students of class Nursery played hopscotch in their classes. Through this activity, children were able to recognize numbers more quickly. Such games help in developing gross motor skills, balance, and cognitive skills among the children.
