

REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN THE MONTH OF APRIL'23

STORY TELLING ACTIVITY- “Storytelling is the most powerful way to put ideas into the world”.

Telling stories in front of kids promotes brain development & imagination. It develops language & emotions in kids. Pre-Nursery students enjoyed the Tortoise & Rabbit story. The class teacher narrated the story and explained the moral and values gained from it. The session was highly interactive and engaging.



JUMPING ACTIVITY-Floor activity is the best way to teach new concepts to the children. With this view in mind, a jumping activity for circle shape was conducted for the students of Pre- Nursery where they jumped inside the circle. They were able to recognize the circle shape. It also helped in developing leg strength& balance.



DHOL DECORATION ACTIVITY - Dhol decoration activity was conducted for the students of Kindergarten to mark the celebration of Baisakhi. Kids decorated the Dhol with colors, ribbons & beads. This activity helped in developing the fine motor skills of the children.



SIMON SAYS GAME-This game is an excellent way for children to know their body parts. Nursery students enjoyed playing this game in class with their classmates. They participated in the game enthusiastically and touched their body parts as the name called out the name. This activity also helped in developing motor skills, listening skills, and social-emotional skills.



BIG AND SMALL ACTIVITY-This activity helped students to learn to differentiate between big and small objects. Nursery students did this activity with the help of sorting big and small balls from one tub to another. Through this activity, children understood more about the size and it also enabled their eye-hand coordination.



LETTER 's' PEG ACTIVITY-With the help of peg Nursery students matched 's' sound words with the letter. This activity provided an opportunity to improve letter recognition and a better understanding of vocabulary words.



SENSE ORGANS ACTIVITY-Our senses let us experience such variety of things in our daily lives. From eating different kinds of foods to smelling those calming fragrances, feeling of touch, and listening to music our senses enrich our lives with great pleasure. Prep students performed activities on hearing, tasting, and touching for a better understanding of each sense organ and its importance. The children enjoyed it a lot. Through this activity, students observed our sense organs and their importance in our life.



LADDER MAKING ACTIVITY-To reiterate the pre-number concept of tall & short, Ladder Making Activity was conducted for the students of the Prep class. By pasting the ice cream sticks children made two ladders of different sizes. They measured their height and were able to differentiate between tall & short ladders. This activity is a fun and interactive way for kindergarten children to learn about size and height differences.





CLAY ACTIVITY- A clay modeling activity was conducted for the students of kindergarten. Playing with clay is an interesting way to encourage a child's imagination & creativity. With the clay, they made different shapes. This activity helped them in their eye-hand coordination too.
