REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

Role Play Activity- Nursery children enjoyed learning about various community helpers through the role-play activity. Students dressed up as various community helpers enacted their roles with props like a stethoscope, hammer, board, weighing machine etc. The value of 'Respect for all Helpers' was inculcated in them by making them aware that all jobs are important and worthy of respect.



Feed the Jaguar Activity- In this activity, Nursery students picked up the correct pictures having a 'j' sound and put them in the jaguar's mouth. Through this activity, students learned more vocabulary words with the letter and it also helped in improving their eye-hand coordination.
