## REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN THE MONTH OF DECEMBER

**ADDITION ACTIVITY**- Engaging kindergarten students in age-appropriate activities is essential to help them develop various skills while having fun. Our prep students delved deep into the ocean of numbers with play way hands-on-activity of 'Addition'. They practised the concept of addition in a fun way by using cutouts of ladybugs and doing addition with bud printing.





SHOW AND TELL ACTIVITY- A 'Show and Tell' activity was organized for Prep students to develop effective communication skills and build confidence. Children spoke about different community helpers and acted on their character. Through this activity, they also learned the importance of community helpers and their impact on our lives.





**READING ACTIVITY**-Reading activities encourage and develop great learning skills in children of all ages. Nursery students participated in the 'ig' words reading activity. They read the word and matched it with the corresponding picture. It was a fun-filled activity that helped the young learners develop literacy and build knowledge of letter sounds.



**THUMB PRINTING ACTIVITY-** Prep students took an active part in the 'Thumb Printing Activity'. This activity was a wonderful sensory experience for the children. They dipped their thumb in green colour and made an impression on the image of a parrot. This activity helped children improve their eye-hand coordination.



<u>SPONGE DABBING-</u>'Sponge Dabbing' is an excellent way for young children to explore paint. Prep students designed New Year greeting cards by sponge dabbing and expressed their creativity. This activity also helped to improve handeye coordination, fine motor skills and colour recognition.







MYSTERY BAG ACTIVITY- Nursery students were engaged in the "Mystery Bag" activity to enhance their vocabulary. Children sorted the pictures from the mystery bag related to the letter and spoke about the same. It also helped in improving concentration and fine motor skills



<u>Clay Count Number Activity-</u> The Clay Count Number Activity was done with Nursery students to reinforce the object counting concept in them. They made balls according to the number given to them. They all enjoyed playing\_with clay and simultaneously learning object counting.



ORIGAMI CAP MAKING ACTIVITY-Origami is the art of paper folding and a fun way to improve memory, visualization skills, eye-hand coordination and fine motor skills. Prep children-made caps with origami sheets by following instructions given by the teacher. They took the colour paper of their choice and folded it carefully to make a cap. Children participated in this activity with great zeal and a high spirit.



**SNOWMAN MAKING ACTIVITY-** Craft encourages children to play and experiment in a fun and relaxed environment. Through craft activities, they not only learn about shapes or colours but also get an opportunity to explore and express their emotions. Pre-Nursery students pasted two circles on the sheet of paper and made a snowman. They also pasted googly eyes, nose and decorated it



<u>WINTER CAP MAKING ACTIVITY</u>- "Winter is not a season it's a celebration". Pre-nursery students welcome the season with great zeal and enthusiasm.
