

Glance Of activities conducted in the month of December

Paper Crumpling Activity-

Paper Crumpling activity was conducted on 16th December'21 for Prep students to improve their fine motor skills and coordination. Children enjoyed making beautiful bouquets by crumpling and pasting colourful papers.



Origami Cap Making Activity-

Origami is an activity that involves the art of folding paper with certain techniques to make something new. Prep children enjoyed making caps as an origami activity. They were enthusiastic about this activity and showed their creativity by making colorful winter caps. This activity enhanced the fine motor and creative skills of the students.



Show & Tell Activity (Community Helpers)

Kids learned the numbers while having fun with this number craft activity. They enjoyed finger dipping with their fingers according to the number. This activity helped in developing early math skills - like number recognition and sequencing.



Jelly Fish & Rabbit Making Activity-

Various craft activities were designed for Nursery children to provide a platform to enhance the artistic capabilities of the young creative minds. Children made beautiful jellyfish & rabbits. With exposure to these various types of crafts, the youngsters developed their craftsmanship interests, problem-solving skills, fine motor skills, and even social skills.
